



YEAR: 3 TERM : 1 THROUGH THE AGES

English: Reading:

We will be following the Schofield and Sims reading scheme. Pupils will enjoy extracts from authors such as James Berry, Michael Morpurgo and Patricia Cleveland-Peck as they explore a variety of fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts. We will also have discrete reading lessons where we will discuss books, themes and the enjoyment of reading.

Writing: Stone Age Boy.

In English this term we will be focusing on writing exciting sentences with descriptive language. We will recap the basics (full stops & capital letters etc) we will as introducing expanded noun phrases. Stone Age Boy is our story this term which will help bring their writing to life.

Handwriting: Every Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

We will practise our handwriting during this lesson.

Spellings: Spelling homework will be set each week. This will be set every Friday.

Learning Journey

Through the Ages:



History:

This project teaches children about British prehistory from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, including changes to people and lifestyle caused by ingenuity, invention and technological advancement.

The children will have the opportunity to pose their own questions and research answers related to this interesting and important time period.

Science:

This term, the children will learn about the importance of nutrition for humans and other animals. They will learn about the role of a skeleton and muscles and identify animals with different types of skeleton. The children will have opportunities to engage with practical resources such as life-sized skeleton models. They will apply their learning through tasks such as labelling, practical experiments and educational visitors.



Religious Education:

Art/D.T:

Children will learn about colour theory by studying the colour wheel and colour mixing. They will explore how artists use colour in their artwork using watercolours.
