## ***Letter from the Head Teacher***

Dear Parents,

It was lovely to see so many families enjoying the Easter Egg Hunt yesterday. Thank you to the PTFA and all the volunteers for making this such a success—these events truly matter and make a real difference to our school community.

It has been a busy but enjoyable term, with so much learning taking place. This is always a time of year when children flourish and make excellent progress across many areas, as you will see from the updates below. We remain committed to ensuring that all children continue to make strong progress.

Here are some highlights from our 2025 academic data (further details are available on our website):

- **Early Years (2025):** 77% achieved the expected standard (National: 68.3%)
- **Phonics – End of Year 1 (2025):** 83% passed (National: 80%)
- **Multiplication Tables Check – Year 4 (2025):** 32% achieved full marks (National: 21%)
- **Reading – End of Year 6 (2025):** 83% at expected standard (National: 74%)

- **Writing – End of Year 6 (2025):** 74% at expected standard (National: 72%)
- **Maths – End of Year 6 (2025):** 74% at expected standard (National: 72%)
- **Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (2025):** 79% at expected standard (National: 72%)
- **Science- End of Year 6 (2025)-** 85% at expected standard ( National 82%)

We are pleased with these results; however, we remain ambitious and focused on ensuring that every child makes strong progress from their individual starting points. We will also be sharing updated school data with parents at the end of this academic year, so that you can remain informed about our key performance headlines.

We have greatly valued the support from Parent Forums and the conversations during Parent Consultations. If you would like further information from your child's class teacher regarding homework or ways to support learning at home, please do not hesitate to get in touch. We are always happy to help and work in partnership with you to ensure your child makes the best possible progress. Regular attendance continues to be vital in supporting this.

## Year 6 Bridge Building (Design and Technology)

Last Friday, in Design and Technology, we tested our bridges by carefully placing coins on them one by one to see how strong they were and how much weight they could hold. The children watched closely as each coin was added, noticing how their structures responded and whether they stayed stable or began to bend.

Before the testing, the children had designed and built their bridges using art straws, paper, and masking tape. They explored different shapes and structures, thinking about how to make their bridges strong and balanced. Some chose to use triangles for extra support, while others focused on layering materials or reinforcing key areas.

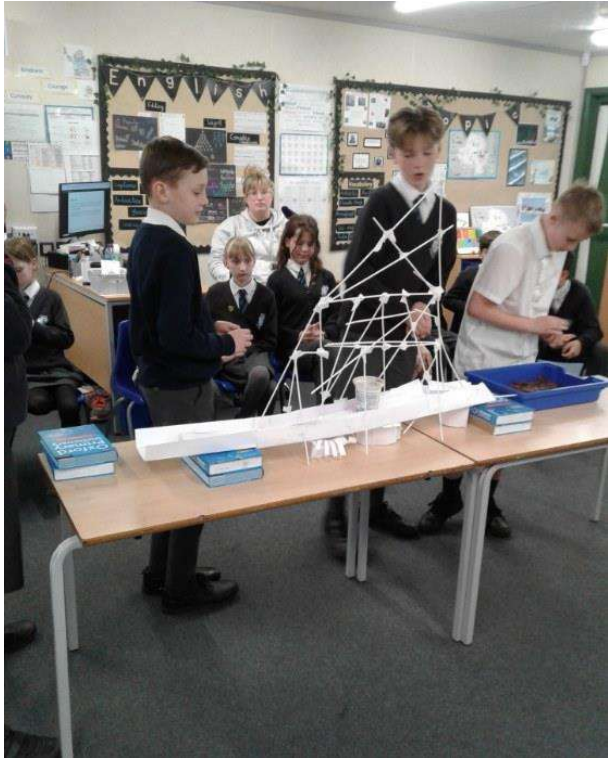
To make it even more exciting, everyone worked in teams and came up with their own engineering team names. A huge congratulations to the 'Bestie Builders', whose design was the winning bridge in 6L, successfully holding an impressive 107 two-pence coins as well as the other winning group in 6CC whose team called themselves 'A Bridge Like no Other Bridge.'

It was a fantastic hands-on activity that encouraged problem-solving, creativity, and teamwork, as the children reflected on their designs and considered how they might improve them in the future.

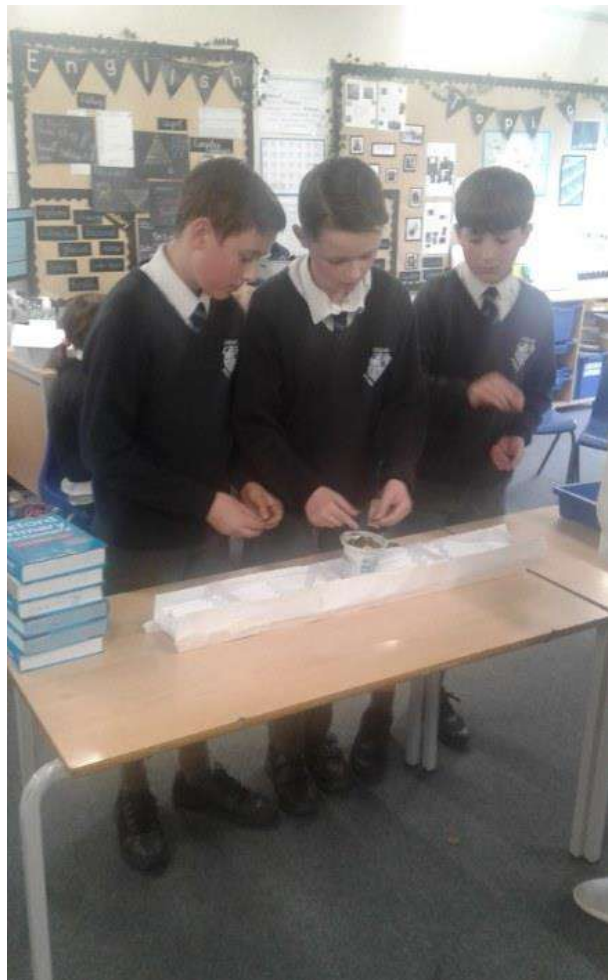
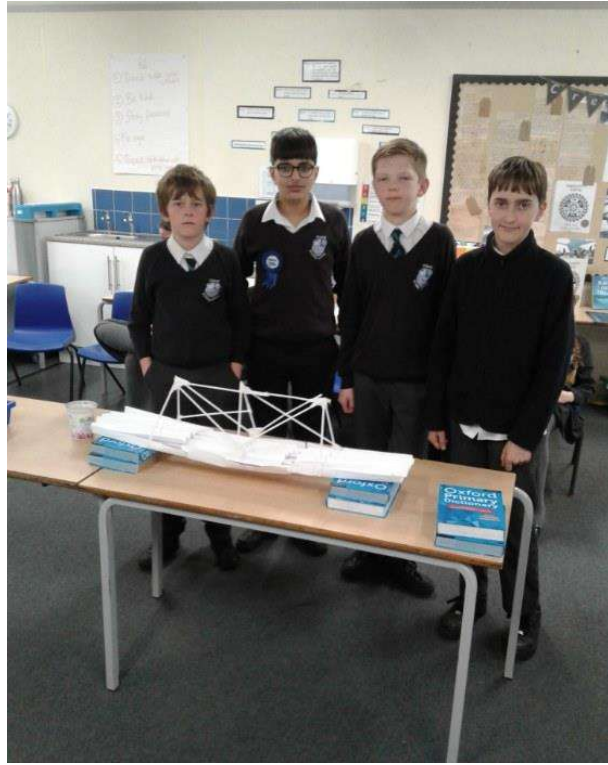

## Year 3 Trip to St Bart's Church

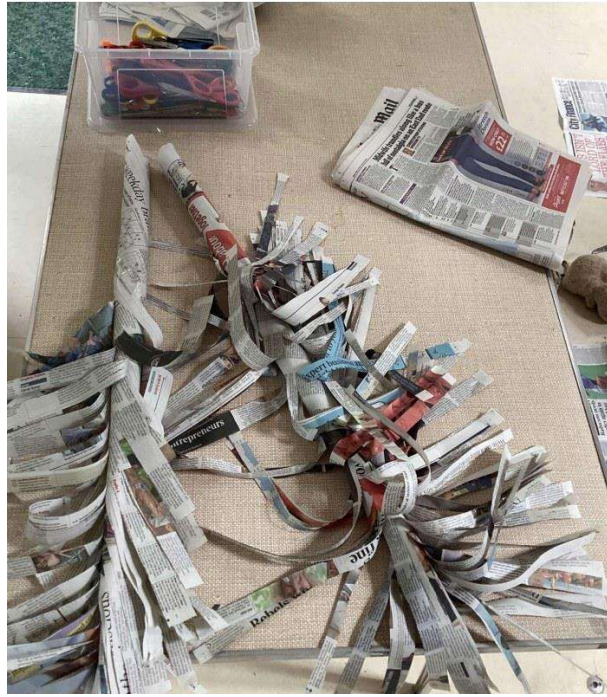
Easter crafts afternoon at St Barts

Thank you to all of the brilliant volunteers. The church are also putting on lots of brilliant Easter activities over the holidays, so do pop by if you have any spare time.

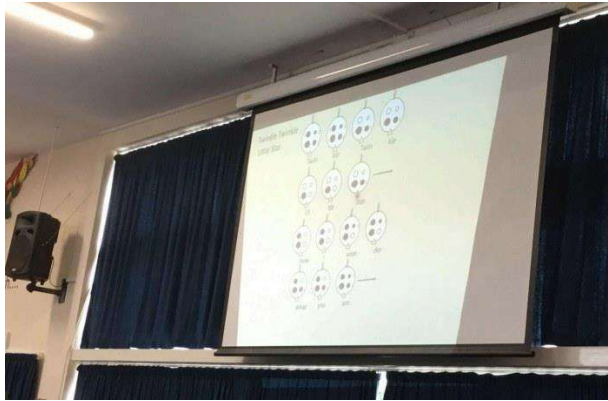






## Year 2 Ocarina Concert

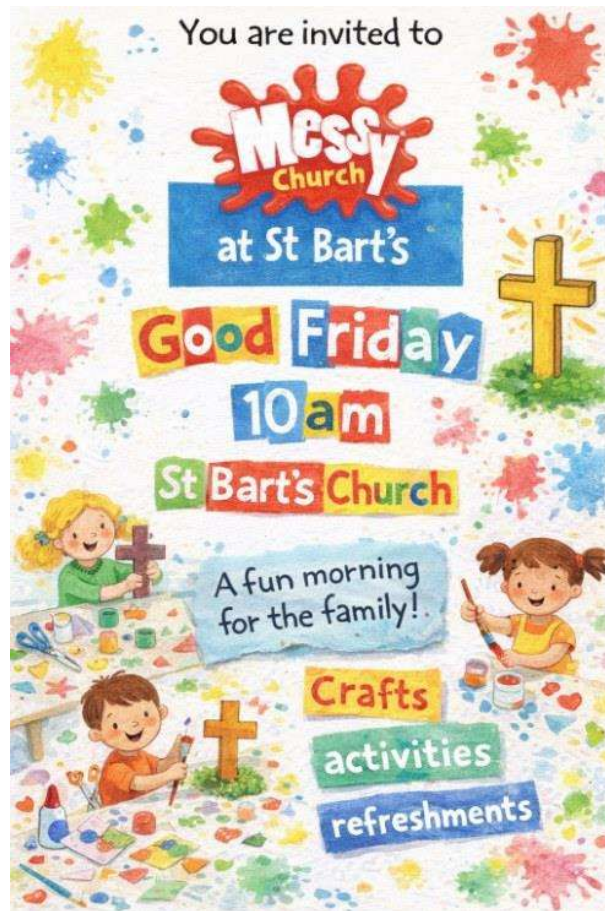

## Attendance Insight

We know that consistent school attendance is so important for your child; the benefits for them are immeasurable! However, sometimes, the numbers can seem vague. Therefore, to put attendance percentage into perspective, we have converted percentages into their weekly equivalent and, even one step further, to express percentage in terms of lessons missed:

- Attendance of **95%** for the year equals **10 days** that your child has been absent- that is **two school weeks** of your child's learning missed for that year. If we consider that children are taught 4-6 lessons a day, then 10 days absence over the course of the school year equates to **40-60 lessons missed**.
  - Attendance of **90%** for the year equals **19 days** that your child has been absent, that is almost **4 weeks** of school missed, or **76-114** lessons missed.
  - Attendance of **85%** for the year equals **29 days** that your child has been absent, that is almost **6 school weeks** missed (nearly the equivalent of the summer holidays) or **116-174** lessons missed.
- Attendance of **80%** for the year equals **38 days** absent per year, that is over **7 school weeks** or **152-228** lessons missed!

**Punctuality Matters** Being frequently late for school adds up to lost learning

- Arriving 5 minutes late every day adds up to over 3 days lost each year
- Arriving 15 minutes late every day adds up to 2 weeks absence a year
- Arriving 30 minutes late every adds up to 19 days absence a year

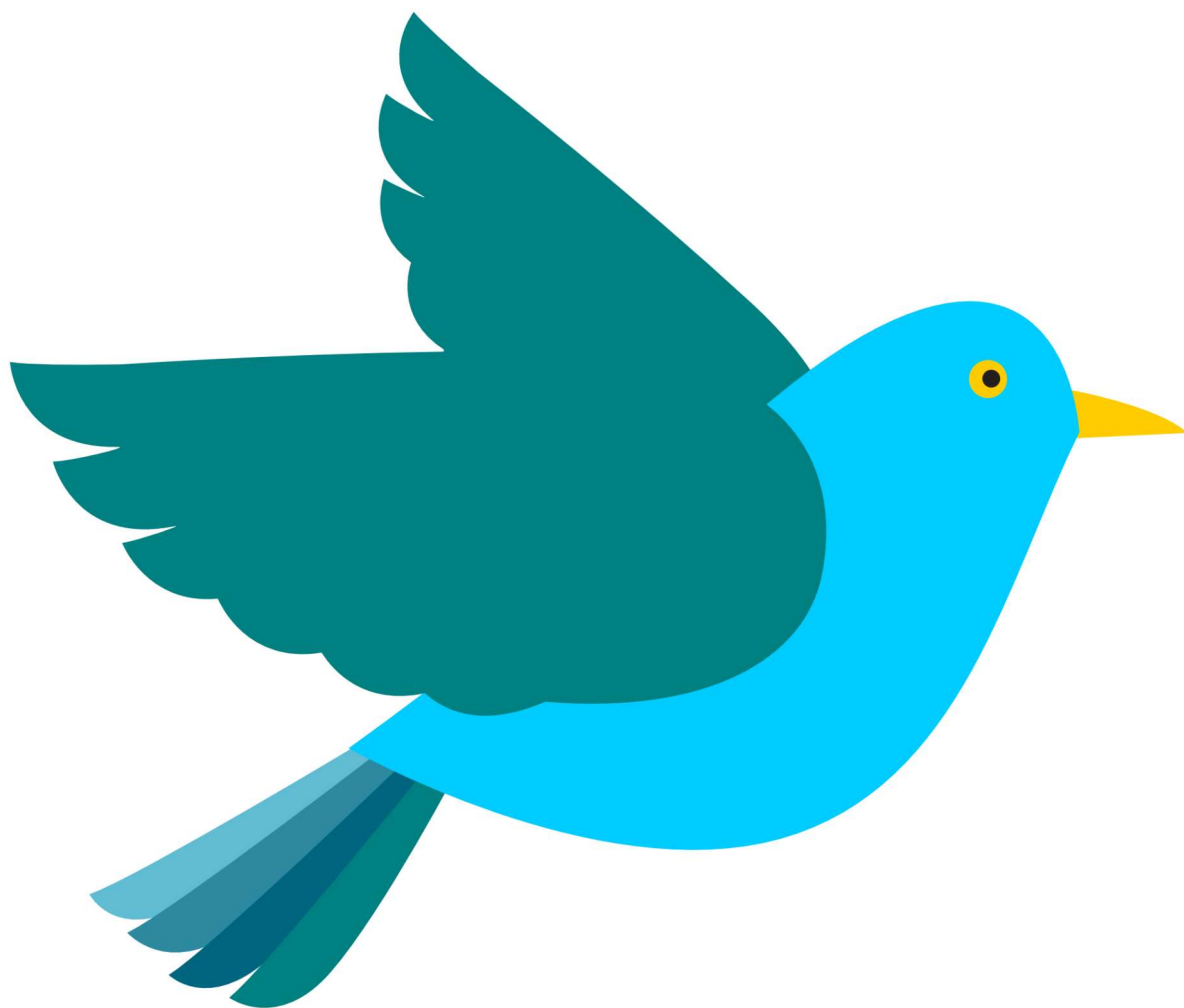
